

Indianapolis Traffic Management Center Indiana State Police Post

The Traffic Management Center for the Indianapolis TrafficWise operation is located at Indiana State Police Post 52, near I-70 and I-465 on the east side of Indianapolis. The center was operational in January 2004 and was dedicated in May 2004. A new State Police dispatch center is located in the Traffic Management Center. State Police dispatchers work in close proximity to the Traffic Management Center operators. This speeds the flow of information and makes emergency response more timely and effective.

This facility replaces the interim Traffic Management Center that began operation in March 2000 in downtown Indianapolis. The coverage area for the Indianapolis Traffic Management Center is all Interstate highways in Marion County and portions of surrounding counties. The TMC also provides space for the Indianapolis area Hoosier Helper freeway service patrol.



Field devices (DMS and HAR) in the Evansville and Kokomo areas are also controlled from the Indianapolis TMC. The TMC is operated 24/7, which allows the Indianapolis TMC to operate field devices normally controlled by the Borman TMC in Northwestern Indiana and the Fort Wayne area.

Deployment of field devices (vehicle detection, CCTV, communications systems, and roadway weather sensors) began in summer 2002 with the communications backbone contract. The deployment of field devices will continue over the next several years.
